These resources are usually <b>available only through the internet</b> and are not meant for distribution through printing. Some news sites (i.e. NYTimes.com) contain material that may or may not be available in print. Look carefully at the site to determine if the content is from a source that publishes the same material in print form.</p> <p>If the material was obtained through the library's databases use the Print Sources sheet.</p> <p>Author's last name, First name. "Title." <i>Web site</i>. Publisher's name, Date (n.d. if none).</p> <p>Web. Date of access. &lt;<a href="http://www.sitename.domain">http://www.sitename.domain</a>&gt; (URL is optional but your instructor may require it).</p>

<p><b>Wikipedia</b></p>	<p>Is never a source for a research paper. There is no listed author, no date, sometimes there are no sources. Entries can be changed by people that may or may not know the topic. Use the information in Wikipedia to find information in our databases or books.</p>
